1. <u>Endangered Mammals of India -</u> Bengal Tiger, Snow Leonard, Black Buck, Nilgiri Tar, One Horned Rhinoceros.

2. State Plants of West Bengal, Arunachal Pradesh, Maharashtra, Kerala, Jharkhand

<mark>B.Sc. (H) –</mark>

 State Plants of Bihar, Arunachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir, Karnataka, Mizoram.

2. <u>Endemic Mammals</u> -Asiatic Lion, Sangai Deer, Lion Tailed Macaque, Kashmir Stag, Pygmy Hog

1.State Mammals-Arunachal Pradesh, Bihar, Jharkhand, Mizoram, Odisha
