- 6. Page 2 to 9 Project Description.
- 7. Page 10 minimum 5 Bibliographic reference and 5 Picture References should ne mentioned.
- 8. Pictures with proper labeling must be there and minimum 5 pictures are required .
- 9. Project can be done in either English or Bengali
- 10.Project should not be copy pasted from any published material.
- 11.Mention CU ROLL NO., REGN NO., COLLEGE ROLL NO. at the top of every page.
