- A candidate who passed the Higher Secondary or its equivalent Examination (10+2 level) on or after 2014 is eligible to apply for admission to the undergraduate courses.
 - A candidate must have passed in English (full marks not being less than 100) in the previous qualifying examination to apply for B.A / B.Sc./B.Com (Honours) Courses.
 - SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B candidates from only West Bengal are eligible for reservation benefits.

AND

1. Eligibility criteria of application for admission in Honours subjects

- a) A minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate (**of best 4 subjects excluding compulsory Environmental Education or Studies**) and 45% marks in the subject or related subject in the pre qualifying examinations

OR

- b) 50% marks in the aggregate when the candidate has not studied the subject in his/her previous qualifying examination provided all other clauses are satisfied.

OR

- c) 55% marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination

Details of Eligibility for Admission in Honors subjects given below in the Table

Aggregate of marks in Best 4 Subjects (*excluding compulsory Environmental Education or Studies*). But if the subject "Environmental Science" is studied as an **elective** subject of 100 marks in the pre-qualifying examination, it may be taken into account for the purpose of determining aggregate marks).

Physics	50%	45% in Physics and passed in Mathematics
Chemistry	50%	45% in Chemistry and passed in Mathematics and Physics
Mathematics	50%	45% in Mathematics
Economics	50%	Passed in Math or Business Math or Business Economics including Business Math (If studied Economics in (10+2) level obtained 45% marks in Economics)
Computer Science	50%	Passed in Mathematics and any one of the Physics/ Statistics/ Computer Science with 50% marks in aggregate or 45% marks in Computer Science and passed in Mathematics
Bengali	50%	45% in Bengali
English	50%	45% in English
Hindi	50%	45% in Hindi
History	50%	45% in History (If not studied History, aggregate 50% only)
Political Science	50%	45% in Political Science (If not studied Political Science, aggregate 50% only)
Philosophy	50%	45% (If not studied Philosophy, then Psychology/Math/Education/Sociology/Political Science can be treated as related subjects)
Journalism and Mass Communication	50%	-----
Commerce	50%	45% in subject or related subject

N.B. If one candidate choose any Science subject as General paper he/she must passed in that paper (s) in (10+2) level

2. Eligibility criteria of application for admission in General Degree Courses:- B.A, B.Sc, B.Com.

Stream	Criteria
Pure Sc.	Passed in (10+2) level
Bio Sc.	Passed in (10+2) level (must have passed in chemistry and Botany or Zoology)
B.Com	Passed in (10+2) level
B.A.	Passed in (10+2) level

AND

A candidate shall be allowed to take up the subject(s) under heading “A” if he/she had passed the subject(s) under heading “B” at the previous qualifying examination.

Marks Criteria for S.C./S.T. candidates as per C.U. Rules

1. 40% in the aggregate or subject or related subjects at the previous qualifying examination, for all honours courses.
2. Passed in 10+2 or equivalent examination for all general courses.
