DESIRING to engage in inter cooperation between "The Parties" in Educational Exercises, Academic and Training Programmes and Research Activities,

PURSUANT to the prevailing laws and regulations, policies and procedures of India,

HAVE REACHED the following understanding:

About the Institutions

On the 15 July 1941, a great expectation of the people living North of Beadon Street was fulfilled with the foundation of Maharaja Manindra Chandra College at 20, Ramkanto Bose Street, Kolkata-700003. It had been possible due to the drive and initiative of some spirit of Dr. Panchanan Neogi I.E.S (Retd.), a well-known educationist of the time and the benevolence of Maharaja Sris Chandra Nandi of Cossimbazar. The genesis of the college may be traced to a public meeting held on December 15, 1940, at 44/A, New Shyambazar Street. A resolution was adopted in that meeting to the effect that an Arts, Science and commerce college be opened in memory of the illustrious Maharaja Manindra Chandra Nandi of Cossimbazar at 20, Ramakanto Bose Street, Kolkata. His son Hon'ble Maharaja Sris Chandra Nandi kindly consented to hand over the premises to the proposed Governing Body of the College. The College, in course of time, under the able stewardship of its illustrious Principals, assumed the status of one of the premier colleges of Kolkata and has been accredited by NAAC in the year 2011 with grade 'B'. The College has celebrated its Platinum Jubilee in the Session 2015-16.

FOR ME AND BY ME FOUNDATION (FMBM) (80G (URN: AADCF9569RE20219) certified and 12AA affiliation) (PAN No: AADCF9569R) was incorporated on 23rd December 2019 to provide economic empowerment and skill development opportunities to deserving women entrepreneurs. The goal is to provide a platform to promote and support women entrepreneurs. Training opportunities are being provided to female students and new women entrepreneurs successfully. The directors of FMBM had worked with real life women entrepreneurs for the last few years.

Presently FMBM is associated with the following activities:

- Organising Trainings, workshops and exhibitions to provide selling platforms to women entrepreneurs.
- Providing free stalls during their own offline exhibitions to NGOs and also to women who belong to grassroots level.
- Promoting business of women entrepreneurs through social promotion, along with individual selling of products through Facebook live and word of mouth.

FMBM has also come up with a unique idea of 'Goody Basket' for all occasions. Through this basket/tray/bag FMBM is selling products of different entrepreneurs together and customers are given a chance to customize the baskets according to their choice of products.

- Collaboration has been done with Wadhwani Foundation and entrepreneurs got an opportunity to get training from experts of Wadhwani Foundation to upscale their business.
- Providing entrepreneurship courses to the interested students organized by the colleges where experts are helping the students to give shape to their dreams.
- Launching internship programme "Dream Chasers", where students have been engaged with the
 entrepreneurs so that they can mutually benefit each other.

Article 1

OBJECTIVE OF COOPERATION

The objective of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to cooperate each other in educational projects in areas of mutual interest

Article 2

SCOPE OF COOPERATION

The Parties agree to implement cooperative programmes including but not limited to:

- a. Exchange of best practices.
- b. Internship Opportunities of students with entrepreneurs.
- c. Skill based certification / add on certification courses (30 to 60 hours, Entrepreneurship Training Course, Hands on Training Workshops).
- d. Promotion of entrepreneurial activities among the students.
- e. Organizing seminars / webinars / conferences / symposia, live training workshops etc.
- f. Developing entrepreneurial culture within the campus through inter/intra college activities.
- g. Undertaking Joint Research Programmes where possible.
- h. Organising Green Initiative Programmes
- i. MSME location or site visit
- j. Course offered:
 - i) Entrepreneurship Course
 - ii) Seminar cum Training Workshop Course
 - iii) Internship in Entrepreneurship Course
 - iv) Career Development Course

Article 3

FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENT

Any cooperation under this MOU is subject to the availability of funding sources and approval of the relevant authorities.

FMBM will charge nominal registration fees from the participants which will vary from programme to programme.

Article 4

LOCATION OF ACTIVITIES

- The Parties agree to implement the programmes stated in Article 2 at Maharaja Manindra Chandra College and any other appropriate venue relevant to the programme or if necessary it can be dione
- 2. Any changes of the location of the programmes shall be mutually agreed upon by the Parties.

Article 5

MODE OF CONDUCTING THE PROGRAMMES

The programmes will be conducted primarily in the Offline mode. Ample arrangements should also be made to conduct programmes in the Online mode if required.

Article 6

DURATION AND TERMINATION

- 1) This MOU shall enter into force on the date of signing.
- 2) The MOU shall remain in force for five (5) years and may be extended for another 5 years by the mutual written consent of the Parties.
- There may be modification or alteration in the type of cooperative programmes after one (1) year with mutual consent of the Parties
- 4) Either Party may terminate this MOU at any time by giving written notice to the other Party on its intention to terminate this MOU, at leasts six (6) months prior to the date of the termination.
- 5) The termination of this MOU shall not affect the completion of any project/s and programme/s in progress and not completed at the time of termination.

Article 7

AMENDMENT

- This MOU may be amended or revised at any time by mutual written consent of the Parties and such amendment shall form an integral part of this MOU.
- Such amendment/s or revisions shall come into force on the date as may be determined by the Parties.

Article 8 SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

Any dispute concerning the interpretation and/or application of this MOU shall be settled amicably through consultations or negotiations between the Parties.
